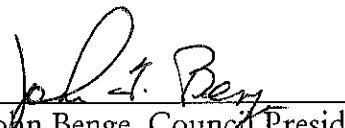

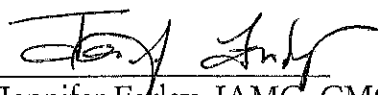
Hamilton County Contract: Mrs. Voller will revise a few lines in the contract and have it ready for next meeting.

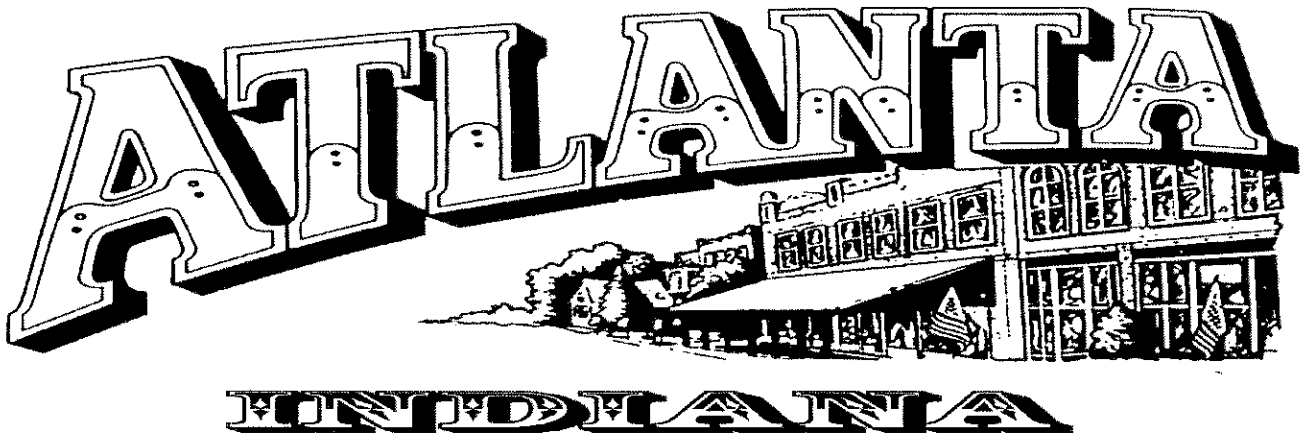

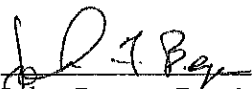

Jeff Muszar and Trustee Cook

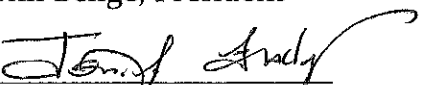
Mrs. Farley reported:
