

Sewer Project: Mr. Emmert gave an update on the sewer project. He informed the council, after reviewing the project plans, he would like to make several additions to the map. These additions would consist of manhole lining, removal, and additional bypass. He would like to also investigate lining the lift station with any extra funds available. After a lengthy discussion the council agreed with Mr. Emmert on the changes. Mr. Emmert also informed the council he has been in contact with Hamilton County concerning grant monies in the amount of \$500,000.00. He is waiting on their response. If awarded, we would use this to relocate and line the remaining sewers.


