REPORTS

Water, Wastewater, & Streets: Andy Emmert

Mr. Emmert gave a verbal report due to computer problems. He informed the council:
Bac-T and Water Reports are complete.

He repaired 1 water meter setting and a water main leak that took 2 weeks to detect and was leaking 40,000 to 50,000 gallons a day into the sewer. He has also been collecting weekly sewer samples. Results have been normal.

Sewer Project update: After giving a short update for the sewer project, Mr. Emmert informed the council he has received a price of \$299,014.00 from Miller Pipeline to have the remaining 30 sewers lined. After a lengthy discussion, Mr. Phifer made a motion to approve the remaining sewers for lining, if it falls within the \$500,000 ARPA money that was received from the County. Mr. Bengé Seconded.

Consumer Confidence Water Report: Mr. Emmert explained the Annual Drinking Water Quality Report, that is required by IDEM, and that he sent out in June. There were a few questions and comments from residents on social media that he addressed.

Certified Lab: Mr. Emmert would like for the Council to consider having our own certified lab at the sewer plant. During the last sewer project, the new building was set up to have a lab. This investment can be paid for from grant money.

Generator: After Endeavor Communications replaced their 275-gallon diesel generator, they donated it to the town. After a short discussion concerning where to use it, the Council would like for Mr. Emmert to price out what it would cost to use this at the sewer plant.


Water Tower: Midco Diving is scheduled to be here before the end of July.
