Rules/Regulations:

2. Must complete and submit a registration form and signed release form to participate.
3. Golf cart must have a permit with the Town of Atlanta.
4. Driver must have a license and be at least 16 years old.
5. All passengers must have a seat.
6. Participants are encouraged to have a supply of "throws" and may have music on cart.
7. Bicycles and walkers are welcome but still need to fill out this form.
8. If you would like to undertake making your own float, we welcome that as well.
